From Guildford take the A3 towards Portsmouth. Go through Hindhead Tunnel. Take next exit signposted to Grayshott. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit to Grayshott. At the next roundabout take the 2nd exit. This takes you on a road running alongside the A3. After about ½ mile turn right signed Bramshott Chase. Then take the first right before the underpass into Bramshott Chase Lane. Chase Farm will be found on the right.

From Portsmouth take the A3 towards Guildford. Just before the Hindhead Tunnel take the exit to Bramshott Chase. Take the first turning on the right into Shannon Court Road (before going under A3 bridge) and immediately left into Bramshott Chase Lane. Chase Farm will be found on the right.
