Results: Score sheets from each heat can be collected at the next heat.
Copies will be sent by WhatsApp/email when finalised.

Scoring:

The three highest point scores from the five possible Minis League dates will be combined to give the final league results.

1st place - 10 points, 2nd place - 9 points, 3rd place - 8 points, etc to 8th place - 3 points

- Any competitor not placed 1st – 8th will receive 1 point.
- In the event of a tie the rider with the highest collective marks will win.

Rosettes: Rosettes to all at the end of the League.

Turnout: Smart turnout expected but no need to plait, no need for competition dress. i.e. turnout as per a Rally – cream/beige jods, shirt, Pony Club Tie, Pony Club Badge, Pony Club Sweatshirt.

Hair: Must be tied back securely, in a safe manner to reduce the risk of hair being caught and to prevent scalp injuries. **A hairnet is recommended.**

Jewellery: the wearing of any sort of jewellery when handling or riding a horse/pony is not recommended and if done at any Pony Club activity, is done at the risk of the member/their parent/guardian. However, to stop any risk of injury, necklaces and bracelets (other than medical bracelets) must be removed, as must larger and more pendulous pieces of jewellery (including those attached to piercings) which create a risk of injury to the body part through which they are secured. For the avoidance of doubt a wristwatch, wedding ring, stock pin worn horizontally and/or a tie clip are permitted.
